TITLE: FREEDOM BY THE NEW COVENANT

TEXT: Zechariahs 9:11; John 8:31-36

Zechariah 9:11 (KJV) "As for thee also, by the blood of thy covenant I have sent forth thy prisoners out of the pit wherein is no water."

BIBLE READING: (For the week) Romans 8:1-39

INTRODUCTION:

The new covenant in Christ Jesus, guarantees believers total freedom from every form of bondage and limitations in this world. God established the new covenant by giving His only Son to die once and forever for the sin of mankind. The following are the freedoms that the new covenant guarantees:
- a) Free From condemnation to enjoy Eternal life. John 3:16.
- b) Free from sin and death to enjoy abundant life in Christ. Romans 8:1.
- c) Free from poverty to enjoy Prosperity. 2 Cor. 8:9.
- d) Free from Sickness to enjoy health. 1 Peter 2:24.
- e) Free from curses to enjoy blessings. Galatians 3:13-14.
- f) Free from mediocrity to manifest excellence. 1 Pet. 2:9. Mention others.
