Text: 2 Cor. 5:17-21; Memory Verse: Eph. 2:1

Introduction:

As we continue, the purpose here is for you to realize your new identity in Christ. You are now a new person. Your old sinful nature has passed away. You are now born of God. The nature of God is born in you. You are a new creature, a new creation, a new specie. The nature of God is in you, therefore, you must learn how to live your new life just as a newborn baby must learn to do certain things in this world. I Pet. 2:2. - A different interest; Romans 8:5-8
- Love for Fellowship; I John 3:14
- God's law is written in your heart; **Heb. 8:10b**

YOUR NEW STATUS 6.

- You are redeemed; I Cor. 6:20; Rev. 5: 9-10
- You are free from the bondage of Satan and Sin; Rom. 8:2
- You are transferred into God's kingdom; Col. 1:13-14
- You have access to God's throne; Eph. 2:18
- You are now righteous; II Cor. 5:21
- You are now God's Ambassador on earth; II Cor. 5:20
- You have power over Satan and Sin; Luke 10:19
- You are a new creature; II Cor. 5:16 17

7. **HOW TO SUCCEED**

- Search the scriptures daily; II Tim. 2:15; I Pet. 2:2; Acts 17:11
- Pray without ceasing; I Thess. 5:17; Luke 18:1; Eph. 6:18
- Confess every known sin (fellowship vs. relationship); I John 1:9; Prov. 28:13
- Preach the gospel to others; Acts 1:8; Mark 16:15-22; John 15:16
- Enter into spiritual activities without reservation; Romans 12:11
- Give your tithes and offering faithfully and regularly; Prov. 3:9 10; Mal. 3:8 12
- Surrender to the leading of the Spirit; Gal. 5:16; Eph. 5:18; Romans 8:14
- Examine yourself daily; II Cor. 13:5, 8.
- Attend church services regularly; **Heb. 10:25**

Any believer who fails to follow these steps will end up backsliding; **Heb. 7:25** - Jesus wants to help you make it to the very end. Remember this: "I am not going to be a spectator."
